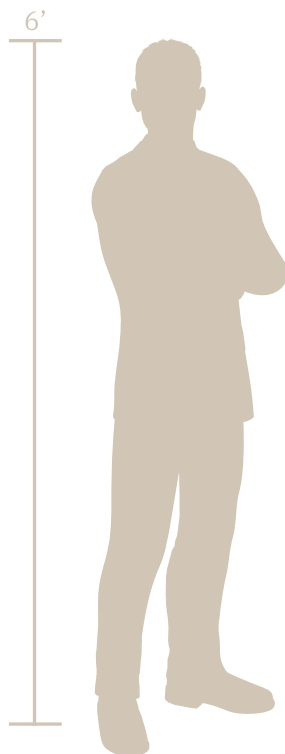


## Antwerp<sup>©</sup> (ATW)
